INTRODUCTION

Arriving in Canada from another country? Let this guide help you prepare for your arrival. The information provided here is based on official government updates. As things continuously change, please make sure you always check the official updates on these websites:

- → <u>COVID-19: Travel, testing, quarantine and borders</u>
- → International students: Travel restrictions and exemptions

Please take some time to review the information in this package. By not following this protocol, students may be denied entry into the country. Government authorities may also fine students for non-compliance in certain situations.

Our top priority is the health and safety of our students, faculty, staff, partners, and community. We are obligated to follow the regulations and recommendations of the Canadian and provincial governments, and the local public health authority. This includes recording the flight information and self-isolation plans for all of our arriving international students; you must send us this information before departing your home country.

At the end of the document is the **COVID-19 Travel and Arrival Protocols Declaration**.

This document, along with your **flight information** and **self-isolation plan**, must be signed and sent to **Justine Higgs** at **justine.higgs@lasallecollegevancouver.com** before you leave your home country.

COMMUNICATION AND RELATIONSHIP BUILDING


If you will be staying in a homestay, contact your host family to get to know each other. A video chat using Zoom or Skype is a good way to do this. Remember to exchange emails and cell phone numbers with your host family.

If you will be staying in a residence/dormitory/hotel, please ensure that you have the correct contact information for them, as well as for any private transportation service that you may be using.

You should also enter the LaSalle College Vancouver telephone number into your cell phone.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS: TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS AND EXEMPTIONS

Make sure you always check the following website for the latest official updates on Travel, testing and borders: <u>https://travel.gc.ca/travel-covid</u>

The following information is from the Government of Canada website. A summary is included here:

To be able to enter Canada as a student, you must meet 2 requirements:

- 1. You must have a valid study permit or a letter of introduction that shows you were approved for a study permit.
- 2. You must be attending a designated learning institution (DLI) with a COVID-19 readiness plan approved by its province or territory. LaSalle College Vancouver is a DLI with an approved readiness plan.

Before you travel

Use the same email address for all of your entry requirements, where applicable (that is, when registering for COVID-19 testing upon arrival and creating your ArriveCAN account).

□ Find out if you can enter Canvada

□ Check if you qualify as a fully vaccinated traveller

□ <u>Get your pre-entry COVID-19 test</u>

- □ Have a quarantine plan in case you don't receive the exemption
- □ Use ArriveCAN to submit your proof of vaccination and quarantine plan

Arriving in Canada

Have the following items with you for assessment by a government official at the border:

- □ ArriveCAN receipt
- \Box Proof of vaccination
- □ Pre-entry test results
- \Box Other travel documents

Starting January 15, 2022, to be able to enter Canada as an international student 18 years and older, you must:

- \Box have a valid study permit
- □ be fully vaccinated with Government of Canada approved vaccines
- □ be attending a Designated Learning Institution (DLI)
- □ meet all other travel restrictions and exemptions for international students

Packing

Include the following in your carry-on bag:

- \rightarrow Proof of vaccination in English or French
- \rightarrow Passport
- \rightarrow Study permit and/or TRV approval letters
- → Custodianship Documents (if required)
- \rightarrow Letter of Acceptance
- \rightarrow Host Family Profile with contact information (if applicable)
- → Residence/Dormitory/Hotel information (if applicable)
- → Private transportation service information (if applicable)
- → Completed BC Self Isolation Plan Form
- \rightarrow COVID test results
- \rightarrow Copy of this document signed by yourself (and your parents/guardians
- if you are under the age of 19)
- \rightarrow Change of clothes
- → Snacks

QUARANTINE IN CANADA

All Travelers Require a Quarantine Plan

All travelers to Canada must prepare a quarantine plan. Even if you are fully vaccinated, you must prepare and submit a plan to self-isolate. A border official may exempt you based on the information you provide when you enter Canada. <u>Use this checklist to assess your quarantine plan</u>.

If you need to quarantine, <u>please read the information here carefully</u> as it addresses the following topics:

- \rightarrow When your quarantine starts and ends
- \rightarrow Getting to your place of quarantine (final destination)
- \rightarrow How to report after you've entered Canada
- → While in quarantine
- \rightarrow Penalties and fines

ARRIVAL PLANS

Before you leave your home country, you must download the ArriveCAN app from the Government of Canada and complete a mandatory Self-Isolation Plan for the Government of British Columbia. Both of these need to be complete prior to your arrival in British Columbia.


ARRIVECAN APP

The ArriveCAN app is available for iPhone and Android and can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play. This app must be setup before you arrive at immigration in Canada.

BC GOVERNMENT SELF-ISOLATION PLAN

Before you leave your home country it is very important that you complete the BC Government Support for International Travelers Self Isolation Plan form. When you arrive at the airport you will be asked to show this form, and the information must be correct.

COVID-19 TRAVEL AND ARRIVAL PROTOCOLS

Pre-Departure:

- Ensure you have checked the most recent travel restrictions from the Government of Canada website
- □ If you will be staying with a host family, contact them in advance to discuss expectations, and make sure they have a current photo of you
- □ Provide arrival information and exchange contact information (cell, email)
- Complete, send and print the online Mandatory Self-Isolation Plan (<u>https://travelscreening.gov.bc.ca/</u>), and send a copy to Justine Higgs – Student Services at justine.higgs@lasallecollegevancouver.com
- □ Download the ArriveCAN App (iOS and Android)
- \Box In your carry-on, pack the following:
 - \rightarrow Proof of vaccination in English or French
 - \rightarrow Passport
 - → Study Permit or Study Permit Approval Letter
 - → Custodianship Documents (if required)
 - → Letter of Acceptance
 - → Host Family Profile with contact information (if applicable)
 - → Residence/Dormitory/Hotel information (if applicable)
 - → Private transportation service information (if applicable)
 - → Complete BC Self Isolation Plan Form
 - \rightarrow Medical clearance letter (if you have one)
 - → COVID test results (if you have them) Copy of this document signed by yourself (and your parents/guardians if you are under the age of 19)

COVID-19 TRAVEL & ARRIVAL PROTOCOLS DECLARATION

We look forward to welcoming you to LAB Vancouver. This document must be signed and sent to **Justine Higgs – Student Services** at **justine.higgs@lasallecollegevancouver.com** before you leave your home country.

By signing this declaration, I confirm that I understand and agree that:

- □ I understand I have to comply with the Government of Canada's Quarantine Act, and I'm aware of the penalties of violation of the Quarantine Act, which include up to 6 months in prison and/or \$750,000 in fines.
- □ I have agreed to and signed a copy of the COVID-19 International Student Travel, Arrival and Quarantine Checklist.
- □ I have completed and printed the self-isolation plan for presentation at the port of entry, and have registered via the ArriveCAN App and the COVID-19 BC App.
- □ I have appropriate medical insurance, effective as of the date of my arrival, which includes coverage for COVID-19 during the quarantine period.
