1 IF YOU ARE CURRENTLY LIVING IN THE VANCOUVER AREA...

A And your program includes an on-campus course(s) in the Fall 2020 quarter, then;

- You will be informed of the day(s) and time(s) for your on-campus course(s), and you will be required to read and acknowledge LCV's COVID safety protocols
- You will be informed of the day(s) and time(s) for your online (remote) course(s); please note that these day(s)/time(s) may be scheduling placeholders - remote courses will typically have some synchronous and some asynchronous components, which will be explained by your instructor in the first week of class

- You will be informed of the day(s) and time(s) for your on-campus course(s), and you will be required to read and acknowledge LCV's COVID safety protocols
- You will be informed of the day(s) and time(s) for your online (remote) course(s); please note that these day(s)/time(s) may be scheduling placeholders - remote courses will typically have some synchronous and some asynchronous components, which will be explained by your instructor in the first week of class
